Purpose:

To encourage undergraduate students to pursue teaching careers in science, social science, or engineering at any level of education; from the primary to the post-secondary level.

Eligibility:

The candidates must have:

- A GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Junior or senior status at the beginning of the award period
- 12 or more credit hours per semester (full-time) at IUPUI during the award period.
- Science and/or Math major OR science and/or math focus (see essay requirements)

Award:

A full award recipient may receive a tuition scholarship for up to \$2000. A mentorship with an IUPUI faculty member. Additional special opportunities may be available, depending on the student's own interests and needs.

The award:

- Is for one academic year, fall and spring semester.
- Requires reapplication for renewal.
- Allows a junior year award recipient to apply for a senior year award.
