

# **High Ability Transfer Scholarship**

## Scholarship Purpose:

The purpose of the High Ability Transfer Scholarship is to provide IUPUI with the unique opportunity to attract top caliber transfer students to its campus. The scholarship also seeks to further enhance the academic and social vitality of the campus by supporting the enrollment and subsequent graduation of future scholars who are committed to thriving in IUPUI's inclusive learning environment.

## **Scholarship Description:**

The High Ability Transfer Scholarship is a merit scholarship awarded to outstanding students from all backgrounds that transfer to IUPUI with the intent of completing a Bachelor's degree. Awards are provided to students who qualify for both resident and non-resident tuition status.

Resident Awards: \$5,000 Annual Award (renewable for two years) **Non Resident Awards:** \$9,000 Annual Award (renewable for two years)

#### **Eligibility:**

- Be admitted to IUPUI as a transfer student for the upcoming academic year.
- Have an earned Associate's degree or the transferrable course equivalency.
- Have the ability to complete an IUPUI Bachelor's degree within two years of admission.
- Demonstrate commitment to and appreciation for diversity through service and academic choices.

#### Criteria:

In order to qualify for consideration for the competitive scholarship students must meet the following criteria:

- New transfer student to IUPUI (intercampus transfer students are not eligible).
- U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents.
- Cumulative GPA > 3.75 at point of admission.
- Minimum of 60 transferable credit hours completed.
- Ability to contribute to the diversity of IUPUI articulated in a personal statement.
- Maintain fulltime enrollment and a cumulative IU GPA ≥ 3.3 to receive 2<sup>nd</sup> year funding.
- Students from groups historically underrepresented at institutions of higher education (i.e. first generation, low-income, ethnic minority and women) are strongly encouraged to apply.
